

## **RISK ASSESSMENT 1**

**Site or Area:** All Class V Vessels

**Location or Department:** Steamer and Launch

**Operations covered by this assessment:** Mooring of Vessels/Use of Ropes

**People: Maximum number of persons exposed to the hazard, frequency and duration exposure:**

All Passengers (See Passenger Certificate) and Crew and every 30 minutes (approx) x 3 minute duration (approx)

**Who may be harmed:**

General Public and Crew

**Hazards and severity:** 2 (*1=minor, 2=serious, 3=very serious/fatal*)

**Risk:** 1 (*Likelihood: 1=very unlikely, 2=unlikely, 3=likely/very likely*)

**Product of hazard severity x risk likelihood:** 2 (*1,2,3 = low, 4 = medium, 6 or 9 = high*)

**Actions already taken to reduce the risk:**

- Crew trained in the use of ropes.
- Skipper/Master to inspect mooring ropes for wear and passengers to be kept clear when ropes are in use.

**Assessment of residual risk:**

- Mooring ropes snapping

**Further actions required:**

- Passenger to be kept clear when ropes are in use
